## Netiquette Prompts for Remote Class Sessions

As you establish class norms and expectations for your students, remember to include a statement on your netiquette policies. Consider the following questions to guide your thinking on appropriate standards of online communication and decorum:

- 1) Joining the Remote Class
  - a) Should students arrive early to check their technology settings?
  - b) Will students start in a waiting room?
  - c) Can students join from their phone, or is a computer required?
  - d) How should students expect you to call the class to order?
- 2) BYU Class Standards
  - a) Do dress and grooming rules apply?
  - b) Are students allowed to eat or drink during class?
- 3) Camera and Audio
  - a) When should students turn on their camera and microphone?
  - b) What can students do to minimize distractions to themselves and others? (noise, visual, etc.)
- 4) Class Participation
  - a) How should students signal a desire to participate?
  - b) How will the class Teaching Assistant contribute?
  - c) How should the chat feature be utilized?
  - d) How will breakout rooms be incorporated?
